Program overview

This program will ensure that students become professionals in the field of Biomedical Engineering. The first and second years are almost entirely devoted to expanding one's knowledge of the field. The topic for the dissertation is chosen and the associated research plan is written. After the dissertation is approved and subsequently defended, the student will be awarded the title of B.Eng.
