

# **Academic Program for Master Degree Candidates in Nutrition and Food Hygiene**

## **Program overview**

This program will ensure that students become experts in the field of Nutrition and Food Hygiene. The first year is almost entirely devoted to expanding one's knowledge of the field. The second-year focuses on deepening the understanding of the field and the topic for the dissertation is chosen and the associated research plan is written. In the third year, students will finish their dissertations and after defending, they will be awarded the title of Master of Science.

## **Aim of the program**

The aim of the program is to educate the next generation of Nutrition and Food Hygiene talent to be able to compete with their peers in the global job market. Through extensive training and research practise, students will graduate and hold the Master's degree enabling him or her to work in a hospital or the food industry as a dietitian, in college or a university as a nutritional researcher or instructor and in centers for disease control.
